

X-RAUM Award Ceremony 2021

Since 2012, the Berlin Senate has honored the work of independent project spaces and initiatives in Berlin with the *Award for Artistic Project Spaces and Initiatives*. The award ceremony is organized every year by the *Berlin Network of Independent Project Spaces and Initiatives*.

Also in 2021 ten project spaces and initiatives are receiving the award. It is the ten year anniversary of the prize and under the motto *X-Raum* we are celebrating with a printed publication and a new website featuring all 120 prize winners from the last ten years, as well as reflections on the changes to the Berlin project space scene in the last decade.

This year's award winners are:



The Berlin Network of Independent Project Spaces and Initiatives is an active union that has existed since 2009 for said project spaces and initiatives, specializing in visual arts.

Beyond this award, beginning in 2019 after intense cooperative development with the Berlin Senate, a core funding model for project spaces and initiatives was introduced. In 2020, for the first time, 33 project spaces and initiatives were funded in this way for a two year period.




