in line with the award ceremony for
project spaces and initiatives in 2017**

Wanted are approximately ten contributions around the theme of City-Space, which will be shown during the award ceremony at Bar Babette as well as in an exhibition at c/o KUNSTPUNKT BERLIN.

Art pieces, experimental films, and animations will be accepted - but not documentaries.

We cordially invite you to submit new or older films and videos in digital form with a running time of 30 seconds up to a maximum of 5 minutes, and we hope to receive a high number of entries.

Deadline: 23rd of July 2017

The submitted applications will be viewed and juried by the team organizing the award ceremony. Selected works for the show/presentation will be compensated with a one time fee of 300 euros.

The award ceremony takes place on the **15th of September 2017** as part of Berlin Art Week at Bar Babette, Karl-Marx-Allee 36, 10178 Berlin. At the same time the exhibition *Mind the Space / raumohneraum* will be open to viewers at c/o KUNSTPUNKT BERLIN, Schlegelstraße 6, 10115 Berlin.

Films and videos in mp4 format for compiling a shortlist.
(Pal, 1080p or smaller)

Marked with name, title, year of production, format, length, credits, and copyright

We ask that the film and video pieces be sent as an attached file or as a download link. (maximum 50 MB)

Please only one submission per applicant.

No legal obligation of acceptance for the exhibition is granted. The jury decisions will be announced and contributors will be contacted by e-mail.

Shipping:

Contributing artists are required to cover their own delivery costs as well as eventual insurance expenses for both works & presentations. Presentations sent in will NOT be returned unless a postmarked self-addressed envelope is enclosed.

Legal Rights:

The applicant grants the Network the right to use clips or still photos of the submitted presentation for promotional use within the framework of the exhibition, respectively, to keep the submitted presentations. The applicant guarantees that every person who has taken part in the production of the submitted artworks agrees with participation. The contributor guarantees furthermore, that no third person's or parties' rights are violated through the presentation and/or the submission of the artwork, and that the organizer of the exhibition cannot be sued for any violation regarding these rights. The network is allowed to make copies of the submitted video works onto discs or devices for presentation purposes during the exhibition and for archiving. Finally, the applicant guarantees that he/she is authorized to submit the contribution for admission to the exhibition free of charge, and that he/she holds the copyright of the work.

Application of a presentation automatically means the acceptance of these terms and conditions.
